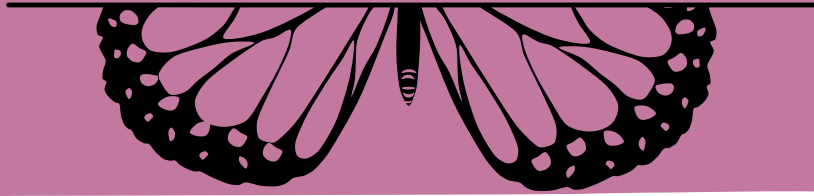

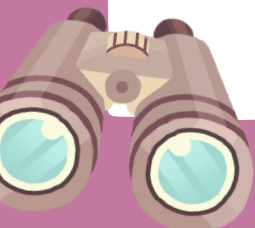


THEME

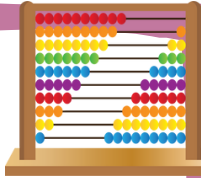

WHAT WILL WE LEARN THIS TERM?

MATHS



PLACE VALUE

- Count in steps of 2, 3, and 5 from 0, and in 10s from any number, forward and backward.
- Recognise the place value of each digit in a two-digit number (10s, 1s).
- Identify, represent and estimate numbers using different representations, including the number line.
- Compare and order numbers from 0 up to 100.
- Use <, > and = signs.
- Read and write numbers to at least 100 in numerals and in words.
- Use place value and number facts to solve problems.

ADDITION AND SUBTRACTION

- Solve problems with addition.
- Apply increasing knowledge of mental and written methods.
- Recall and use addition and subtraction facts to 20 fluently, and derive and use related facts up to 100.
- Add and subtract numbers using concrete objects, pictorial representations, and mentally, including: A Two-digit number and 1s, a two-digit number and 10s, 2 two-digit numbers
- Adding 3 one-digit numbers.
- Show that addition of 2 numbers can be done in any order (commutative) and subtraction of 1 number from another cannot.
- Recognise and use the inverse relationship between addition and subtraction and use this to check calculations and solve missing number problems.

ENGLISH



FICTION: TRADITIONAL TALES AND FABLES

We will:

- Explore fables including 'The Frog and Scorpion' and 'The Ant and Grasshopper'.
- Write dialogue between grasshopper's unhappy sister and cruel ant. We will look at compound sentences. Finally, we will plan, draft and write a fable.

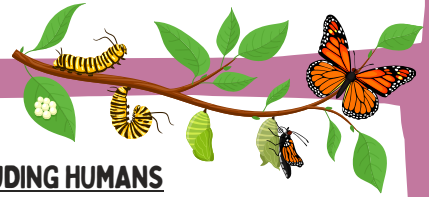
NON FICTION: INFORMATION TEXTS - PETS

We will:

- Explore the beautifully illustrated book about pets: Matilda's Cat by Emily Gravett, as well as other texts.
- Learn how to write using expanded noun phrases and sentence punctuation. Finally, we will plan, draft and write our own information texts.

SCIENCE

ANIMALS INCLUDING HUMANS



We will:

- Notice that animals, including humans, have offspring which grow into adults.
- Find out about the basic needs of animals. (water, food and air).
- Describe the importance for humans to exercise, eat the right amounts of different types of food, and hygiene.

GEORAPHY

SENSATIONAL SAFARI

We will:

- Look at Kenya, to see what life in another continent is like.
- Meet animals, as we travel through the African Safari, and learn about the local culture.



ART

COLOUR CHAOS



We will:

- Learn about about choosing, using and mixing our own colours to create beautiful art work.
- Explore the life and work of six key artists.
- Work mainly with paint, to create pieces in a range of abstract styles.

PE

GYMNASTICS



We will:

- Learn to travel safely in different ways, at different speeds and levels.
- Bounce, hop, hopscotch, gallop, skip, tiptoe and run in different directions.
- Learn to jump safely on the ground and onto and from equipment.
- Jump and roll into different shapes.
- Learn about why we exercise.

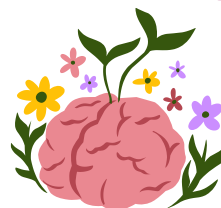
FAMILY AND COLOURS
