WHAT WILL WE LEARN THIS TERM?

PLACE VALUE

MATHS

- Explore Roman numerals to 1,000.
- Read, write, order and compare numbers to 1.000 and determine the value of each
- Identify, represent and estimate numbers using different representations
- Recognise the place value of each digit in a 3-digit number (hundreds, tens, ones).
- Count from zero in multiples of 4, 8, 50 and 100; find 10 or 100 more or less than a given number

ADDITION AND SUBTRACTION

- Add and subtract numbers mentally.
- Add and subtract whole numbers with up to three digits, using formal - written methods of columnar addition and subtraction
- Solve problems, including missing number facts, place value, and more complex addition and subtraction
- Estimate the answer to a calculation and use inverse operation to check answers.

ENGLISH

CLASSIC FICTION - STORIES ON A THEME

Explore stories on a theme with Michael Morpurgo's sea stories, 'Dolphin Boy' to explore his use of characterisation, dilemmas, dialogue, word classes and the perfect tense.

POEM - POETIC LANGUAGE

Read poems, exploring images created through language. Write and perform image poetry about animals and weather. Study noun phrases and prepositions for time, place, cause.

ANIMALS INCLUDING HUMANS

- Describe the differences in the life cycles of humans and animals
- Explore how animals survive and stay healthy. Learn how different animals eat different types of foods and need different proportions of nutrients
- Recognise more about what makes a healthy, balanced diet.
- Learn about the nutrients that different foods provide and how these nutrients help our bodies.
- Recognise the different types of skeleton in an animal
- Recognise the difference muscles and bones in a human.

GEOGRAPHY PLACE TO BE - UK

Within this topic, we will recognise the characteristics and vital facts about our country - United Kingdom. We will consider the geography of the UK from the physical features of mountains, rivers and seas to the man-made regions and counties. We will find out how the UK has changed over time, looking at how London grew and how the population of the UK as a whole has changed throughout the course of history.

AUTUMN ART

This 'Autumn' themed lessons will teach us how to use pencil, colour, paint, print, collage and paper to create quality art work that shows progression in skills. We will also have the opportunity to explore the work of several paintings of Autumn scene.

SWIMMING

In PE, this term we will be visiting the swimming pool every week on Tuesday. Swimming will develop our flexibility, strength, stamina, technique, control and balance. Year 3 will be able to learn new skills and techniques during this time.

COMPUTING

We will apply our knowledge and understanding of networks, to appreciate the internet as a network of networks which need to be kept secure. We will learn that the World Wide Web is part of the internet, and will be given opportunities to explore the World Wide Web for ourselves in order to learn about who owns content and what we can access, add, and create. Finally, we will evaluate online content to decide how honest, accurate, or reliable it is, and understand the consequences of false information.
